## Mail –A –Graphic Tournament Rules

1. Entries will be open to members of the McCook Area USBC. Every entrant must be a member of USBC. Unmarried students under the age of 18 must file a parental consent form.
2. This is a singles event tournament. There will be 3 games used for one night of league bowl. If you bowl on more than one league, you must designate which league you will use on entry form. You may enter this tournament from any and all leagues that you bowl as long as you pay for each league.  
(Multiple league entries allowed)
3. Entrants must use their highest USBC certified average from previous season.
  - a. Highest previous regular season average for at least 21 games
  - b... If A does not apply, highest summer league average for at least 21 games as of the end of the previous summer season
  - c. If A, B does not apply, entrant shall use your current average of at least 12 games at the time of bowling
  - d. An entrant who has no average meeting tournament requirements must enter tournament with an average of 200 scratch.
4. Handicap will be 80% of the difference between 200 and the highest average
5. Any protest affecting eligibility or play rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager before the tournament prize payments are made.
6. The Association may declare co-champions, in each division, if there is a tie for the first place, with first and second prize money divided equally. When ties for other than the first place occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the ties positions winners.
7. Prize money returned 75 %. 25% will go to the McCook Area USBC as a fund raiser. The ratio of prizes will be at least one (1) prize out of every 5 entries per division.
8. **League Secretaries must verify ALL scores and provide these scores on the score sheets provided to the league secretaries after entry fees have been collected with all current information which includes: Which lanes bowled at, which league bowling in, current average and scores. These must be returned to: Sam Natcher, McCook Association Manager, PO Box 577 Carrollton, OH 44615 by no later than November 25<sup>th</sup> 2023.**
9. The board of directors of the McCook Area USBC shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.
10. McCook Area USBC WBA will not honor tournament prize checks if not cashed within 60 days
